Margy Wicker's Cheese Grits

Serves 6

1 cup	quick grits
1/2 lb.	Velveeta cheese (cut into cubes)
To taste	Garlic salt (I use garlic powder for more garlicky taste)
1 stick	margarine (I use real butter) cut into cubes
2 eggs	Milk (do not use 2% or skim)
	Grated sharp cheddar (I use extra sharp)
	Paprika (optional)

Cook grits according to directions on package. Add Velveeta, butter, and garlic to cooked grits, stir to melt in butter and cheese. Break 2 eggs into measuring cup, beat, and add enough milk to fill to one cup. Add this mixture to grits and other ingredients. Mix all ingredients well, and pour into buttered casserole dish.

Bake 45 minutes at 300 degrees, uncovered. Remove and top casserole with grated cheddar cheese and dashes of paprika. Bake for 10 more minutes.
