I decided that before we started back at the beginning, we'd include the names of friends of our church who worship with us regularly. For the next several weeks you'll see their names in the bulletin, and we hope you'll pray for them. This is one of the many things we've grown pretty good at asking you to do. It seems we're always asking someone to do something.

I had an interesting phone call Sunday afternoon. Gloria Hawkins is one of those friends of our congregation who worships here as much or more as some of our members. What some of you may not know is that Gloria is a member of the local Lutheran congregation, Trinity Lutheran on Virginia Avenue. That congregation is small and does not have worship every week, and when it does worship, it meets on Saturday afternoon. Gloria and her family worship with us on most Sundays. She comes on Wednesday nights, participates in the Nutty Knitters on Thursdays, and comes to many other things here. (Fred Harmon is also a member of Trinity Lutheran and worships with us, too.) Gloria called to say she had seen her name on the prayer calendar in Sunday's bulletin. She said she wasn't sure what that meant she was supposed to do, but she would be happy to do whatever she was supposed to do when she found out. She assumed she was supposed to be praying for someone this week, but she didn't know who.

I had the pleasant task of telling her this was one of those times that we were doing something for her instead of asking her to do something for us. Her name was on the prayer calendar so that we'd all be reminded to pray for her (and for Beverly King, another of our friends that week).

We do ask you to do a lot. And we're grateful for your responses. But once in a while we do things for you. Next time you're in worship, check out the prayer calendar and remember to pray for whoever is on the list that week. And know that sooner or later someone will be praying for you when your name shows up there.
